COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$382 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended May 22, 1974.

The principal net decreases were \$116 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery, \$76 million in all other loans and \$71 million to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco.

The largest offsetting increase was \$122 million in loans for other public utilities.
