### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$238 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended June 5, 1974.

The principal net decreases were \$164 million in loans for petroleum refining, \$87 million in loans for commodity dealers and \$52 million in loans for retail trade.

The largest offsetting increase was \$71 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery.

COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL TERM LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Total commercial and industrial term loans were \$43,962 million as of May. This was an increase of \$6,249 million over the comparable data a year ago and an increase of \$563 million from the last Wednesday in April.

The principal net changes were \$160 million in loans for other public utilities, \$75 million in loans for construction and \$69 million in loans for other wholesale trade.

The total of all business term loans on May 29, represents 43 per cent of business outstanding at large commercial banks in the series.
