COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$721 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended June 12, 1974.

The principal net increases were \$151 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery, \$125 million in loans for other public utilities and \$69 million in loans to manufacturers of textiles, apparel, and leather.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$110 million in loans to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco.
