COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$548 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended June 26, 1974.

The principal net increases were \$274 million in loans for other public utilities, \$85 million in all other loans and \$84 million in loans for other durable goods.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$50 million in loans to manufacturers of both machinery and transportation equipment.
