### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$561 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended July 24, 1974.

The principal net decreases were \$302 million in loans for bankers acceptances, \$164 million in loans for communication and \$56 million in total unclassified loans and loans for other wholesale trade.

The largest offsetting increase was \$63 million for foreign and industrial loans.
