### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$135 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended July 31, 1974.

The principal net increases were \$140 million in loans for petroleum refining, \$110 million in total unclassified loans and \$92 million in all other loans.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$176 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery.
