### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$11 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended August 14, 1974.

The principal net increases were \$91 million in loans for transportation, \$58 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery and \$49 million in loans for other durable goods.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$124 million in loans for other public utilities.
