COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$237 million at weekly reporting, large commercial banks during the week ended August 21, 1974.

The principal net increases were \$105 million in loans for retail trade, \$90 million in loans for other public utilities and \$66 million in loans to manufacturers of food, liquor and tobacco.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$64 million in total unclassified loans.
