COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

For immediate release
September 5, 1974

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$106 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended August 28, 1974.

The principal net decreases were \$162 million in loans for retail trade, \$144 million in foreign commercial and industrial loans and \$97 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery.

The largest offsetting increase was \$185 million in all other loans.
