COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$273 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended September 11, 1974.

The principal net increases were \$90 million in all other loans and in loans to manufacturers of machinery, \$84 million in loans for other durable goods and \$56 million in total unclassified loans.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$120 million in loans for retail trade.
