COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

For immediate release
September 25, 1974

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$658 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended September 18, 1974.

The principal net increases were \$253 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery, \$66 million in loans for transportation and \$59 million in loans for construction.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$53 million in all other loans.
