COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

For immediate release
October 30, 1974

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$814 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended October 23, 1974.

The principal net decreases were \$161 million in total unclassified loans, \$137 million in loans to manufacturers of chemicals and rubber and \$128 million in loans for retail trade.

The offsetting increase was \$54 million in loans to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco.
