COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$9 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended November 20, 1974.

The principal net increases were \$171 million in loans for commodity dealers, \$75 million in loans to manufacturers of food, liquor and tobacco and \$67 million in loans for other public utilities.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$82 million in loans to manufacturers of textiles, apparel, and leather.
