COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$294 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended December 4, 1974.

The principal net increases were \$161 million in loans for other public utilities, \$125 million in total unclassified loans and \$73 million in loans for petroleum refining.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$132 million in loans for retail trade.

H.12(b) COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL TERM LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Total commercial and industrial term loans were \$48,090 million as of November. This was an increase of \$7,719 million over the comparable data a year ago and an increase of \$751 million from the last Wednesday of October.

The principal net changes were \$177 million in loans for other public utilities, \$152 million in loans for mining and \$79 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery.

The total of all business loans on November 27, represents 44 percent of business outstanding at large commercial banks in the series.
