COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$181 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended December 25, 1974.

The principal net decreases were \$280 million in loans for retail trade, \$126 million in total unclassified loans and \$80 million in loans for commodity dealers.

The largest offsetting increase was \$162 million in loans for bankers acceptances.
