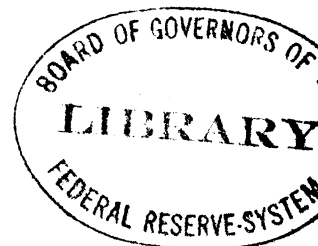

COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$655 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended January 1, 1975.

The principal net increases were \$241 million in loans for other public utilities, \$209 million in loans for transportation and \$205 million in loans for petroleum refining.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$341 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery.
