COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$1,216 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended January 15, 1975.

The principal net decreases were \$256 million in total unclassified loans, \$198 million in all other loans and \$147 million in loans to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco.

The largest offsetting increase was \$120 million in loans for bankers acceptances.
