### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$996 million at weekly reporting banks during the week ended March 12, 1975.

The principal net decreases were \$258 million in loans for retail trade, \$189 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery and \$175 million in total unclassified loans.

The largest offsetting increase was \$59 million in all other loans.
