COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased at a net of \$763 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended May 14, 1975.

The principal net decreases were \$130 million in total unclassified loans, \$119 million in loans to other public utilities and \$74 million in loans to retail trade.

The largest offsetting increase was \$45 million in loans to foreign commercial and industrial loans.
