### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$788 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended May 28, 1975.

The principal net decreases were \$189 million in total unclassified loans, \$134 million in all other loans and \$118 million in loans for transportation equipment.

The largest offsetting increase was \$77 million in loans for mining.
