COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and Industrial loans increased a net of \$274 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended June 18, 1975.

The principal net increases were \$101 million in foreign commercial and industrial loans, \$82 million in loans for transportation and \$66 million in loans for the manufacturing of chemicals and rubber.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$141 million in bankers acceptances.
