### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and Industrial loans decreased a net of \$236 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended June 25, 1975.

The principal net decreases were \$108 million in loans for chemicals and rubber, \$98 million in loans for machinery and \$94 million in total unclassified loans.

The largest offsetting increase was \$91 million in loans for bankers acceptances.
