COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$258 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended August 13, 1975.

The principal net decreases were \$95 million in loans for mining, \$80 million in loans for machinery and \$57 million in total unclassified loans.

The largest offsetting increase was \$56 million in loans for services.
