COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$313 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended August 27, 1975.

The principal net decreases were \$89 million in loans for services, \$62 million in loans for other wholesale trade and \$59 million in loans for bankers acceptances.

The largest offsetting increase was \$76 million in loans for commodity dealers.
