COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$15 million at weekly large commercial banks during the week ended September 10, 1975.

The principal net increases were \$60 million in loans to commodity dealers, \$59 million in loans to bankers acceptances and \$52 million in loans to textiles, apparel and leather.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$163 million in total unclassified loans.
