COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$111 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended September 17, 1975.

The principal net increases were \$67 million in loans for primary metals, \$55 million in foreign commercial and industrial loans, and \$53 million in loans for mining.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$71 million in loans for commodity dealers.
