COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$234 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended September 24, 1975.

The principal net decreases were \$242 million in loans for machinery, \$68 million in loans for textiles, apparel and leather and \$63 million in loans for bankers acceptances.

The largest offsetting increase was \$86 million in loans for petroleum refining.
