COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$135 million at weekly reporting large commercial bank during the week ended November 12, 1975.

The principal net increases were \$151 in loans for bankers acceptances, \$82 million in loans for food, liquor and tobacco and \$64 million in loans for retail trade.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$68 million in total unclassified loans.
