COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$446 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended November 19, 1975.

The principal net decreases were \$160 million in loans for petroleum refining, \$133 million in all other loans and \$86 million in loans for chemicals and rubber.

The largest offsetting increase was \$279 million in loans for bankers acceptances.
