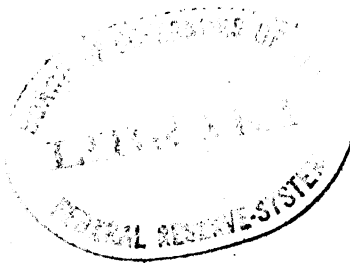

### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$295 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended November 26, 1975

The principal net increases were \$243 million in loans for bankers acceptances, \$117 million in all other loans and \$62 million in foreign commercial and industrial loans.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$62 million in loans for construction.
