COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$206 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended December 31, 1975.

The principal net increases were \$235 million in loans for mining, \$202 million in all other and total unclassified loans and \$172 million in loans for bankers acceptances.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$209 million in foreign commercial and industrial loans.
