### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$608 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending January 21, 1976.

The principal net decreases were \$225 million in all other loans, \$153 million in total unclassified loans, and \$46 million in loans for bankers acceptances.

The largest offsetting increase was \$35 million in loans for mining.
