COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$205 million at weekly reporting large commercial during the week ending February 18, 1976.

The principal net decreases were \$153 million in all other loans, \$46 million in loans for retail trade and \$44 million in loans for other public utilities.

The largest offsetting increase was \$43 million in loans for chemicals and rubber.
