COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$537 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending February 25, 1976.

The principal net decreases were \$165 million in loans for bankers acceptances, \$118 million in unclassified loans, and \$67 million in all other loans.

The largest offsetting increase was \$49 million in loans for textiles, apparel, and leather.
