### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$70 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending March 10, 1976.

The principal net decreases were \$87 million in loans for other public utilities, \$68 million in loans for communication and \$64 million in unclassified loans.

The largest offsetting increase was \$89 million in loans for retail trade.
