COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$462 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending March 31, 1976.

The principal net decreases were \$151 million in loans for construction, \$117 million in loans for transportation equipment, and \$104 million in loans for machinery.

The largest offsetting increase was \$61 million in loans for other wholesale.
