COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$284 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending April 14, 1976.

The principal net decreases were \$95 million in all other loans, \$85 million in loans for other public utilities, and \$79 million in loans for services.

The largest offsetting increase was \$127 million in unclassified loans.
