COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$96 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending April 21, 1976.

The principal net increases were \$111 million in unclassified loans, \$65 million in loans for other public utilities, and \$41 million in loans for commodity dealers.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$91 million in loans for services.
