COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$313 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending May 19, 1976.

The principal net decreases were \$60 million in loans for machinery, \$55 million in loans for transportation, and \$52 million in loans for transportation equipment and services.

The largest offsetting increase was \$60 million in loans for retail trade.
