### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$15 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending May 26, 1976.

The principal net decreases were \$101 million in loans for retail trade, \$56 million in all other loans and \$52 million in loans for construction.

The largest offsetting increase was \$76 million in loans for other public utilities.
