COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$421 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending June 9, 1976.

The principal net decreases were \$214 million in loans for bankers acceptances, \$90 million in loans for other public utilities, and \$71 million in foreign commercial and industrial loans.

The largest offsetting increase was \$89 million in unclassified loans.
