### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$334 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending June 16, 1976.

The principal net increases were \$123 million in loans for retail trade, \$95 million in loans for food, liquor and tobacco, and \$92 million in foreign commercial and industrial loans.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$141 million in loans for petroleum refining.
