COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$315 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending June 30, 1976.

The principal net increases were \$165 million in loans for food, liquor and tobacco, \$113 million in loans for commodity dealers and \$88 million in loans for other public utilities.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$80 million in loans for mining.
