COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOAMS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$727 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending July 28, 1976.

The principal net decreases were \$180 million in loans for bankers acceptances, \$95 million in loans for other public utilities and \$80 million in loans for other retail trade.

The largest offsetting increase was \$49 million in loans for other wholesale trade.
