COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$144 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending August 11, 1976.

The principal net increases were \$240 million for foreign commercial and industrial loans, \$47 million for all other loans and \$33 million in loans for food, liquor, and tobacco.

The largest offsetting decrease \$117 million in loans for other public utilities.
