COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$94 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending August 25, 1976.

The principal net decreases were \$76 million in loans for petroleum refining, \$56 million in loans for transportation equipment and \$46 million in loans for communication.

The largest offsetting increase was \$94 million for all other loans
