### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$103 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending September 8, 1976.

The principal net decreases were \$76 million in loans for retail trade, \$56 million in loans for commodity dealers, and \$41 million in loans for transportation equipment.

The largest offsetting increase was \$94 million in loans for bankers acceptances.
