COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$26 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending December 8, 1976.

The principal net changes were \$101 million in loans for communication, \$54 million in loans for other public utilities, and \$53 million in loans for services and all other loans.

The largest offsetting increase was \$283 million in loans for bankers acceptances.
