### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$84 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending December 29, 1976.

The principal net decreases were \$336 million in loans for retail trade, \$91 million in loans for construction, and \$85 million in loans for textiles, apparel, and leather.

The largest offsetting increase was \$268 million in loans for bankers acceptances.
