COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$210 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending February 16, 1977.

The principal net increases were \$128 million in loans for other public utilities, \$107 million in loans for communication and \$71 million in loans for mining.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$165 million in loans for bankers acceptances.
